## Provincewide Shutdown/Stay-At-Home Order

- **STAY AT HOME**

### TransCanada Pipelines Limited - Inline Inspection Program

TransCanada Pipelines will be conducting a Pipe Maintenance Program in our area. One phase of the project involves in-line inspection to ascertain any areas of corrosion.
